


AFFIDAVIT OF PROOF OF SERVICE

Veteran benches

Council moved to support the Reg Lovell Br. 219's plan to purchase two concrete colour natural veteran's benches for the cenotaph at no cost to the municipality for installation.

Drainage

Council passed resolutions approving the apportionment of drainage assessments on the Mikkelsen Drain and Government No. 4 Drain as well as the Morrow Drain and the Black Branch of the Morrow Drain.

Museums

A report from JoAnn Galbraith was received regarding a seminar she attended in Goderich concerning the formation of a regional group supporting museums and historical institutions in Huron and Middlesex.

Paintball park

As the result of a report received from planner Ted Halwa, council moved to extend the temporary use bylaw to May 9, 2008. The extension will allow sufficient time to review reports requested by and evaluate the past operation of the facility. Any further extensions or approvals to operate the facility beyond the new expiry period will require notice and a public meeting.

Bylaws

Bylaws were approved confirming the proceedings of council and adopting a temporary use bylaw extension for the property at 6425 Riverside Dr.

OMB hearing

The OMB hearing regarding the dog kennel on Carolinian Dr. was extended beyond the first day and is expected to be completed sometime in January.

In camera

Council moved into an in camera session to discuss bylaw enforcement reports, the dog control contract, a request for taxation relief, the payroll report and a driveway entrance issue.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE Newbury Power Inc.

The Ontario Energy Board has received an application on October 31, 2007 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Newbury Power Inc. charges for the electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2008. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2007-0864. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all Newbury Power Inc.'s customers.

Any change to the rates that Newbury Power Inc. charges for electricity distribution will be reflected in the delivery charges. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customer's electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Newbury Power Inc. indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 11.2% increase in the electricity bill. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kw or lower would see an approximate 10.2% increase in the electricity bill.

How to see Newbury Power Inc.'s Application

Copies of the application are available for inspection at the Board's office in Toronto and on its website, www.oeb.gov.on.ca, and at Newbury Power Inc.'s office.

How to Participate in the Rate Proceeding

The Board intends to proceed with Newbury Power Inc.'s rate change application by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any objections to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant at the addresses below no later than December 7, 2007. The Board will not be awarding costs in this matter.

Anyone who wishes information and material from the applicant that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to the applicant on or before December 21st, 2007. The applicant shall file with the Board, complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to all parties who asked interrogatories not later than January 7, 2008.

Anyone who wishes to make a submission on the application must file that written submissions with the Board and deliver it to the applicant by January 21, 2008. If the applicant wishes to respond to the submission(s), the written response must be filed with the Board and delivered to all parties who made submissions by February 4, 2008.
