Re: EB-2023-0140 EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership

Motion to review and vary EB-2022-0184 Decision and Order (Phase 2) relating to Customer Volume Variance Account, and a request for stay of the implementation of certain aspects of the Decision

On June 9th the Board responded by Procedural Order No. 2 to EPCOR's request for an extension to its filing of argument-in-chief from June 22 to July 6, 2023, or two weeks. VECC, a party to this proceeding, did not object to this request.

The Board granted the requested extension and in doing so removed one week from the time after which argument-in-chief is filed for parties to respond with their submissions (from July 13 to July 20).

In the interest of fairness and with the recognition that all parties may be equally affected by changes to schedules (especially considering the summer holiday season) VECC requests that the Board extend the time for intervenor submissions by an equal amount of time and until July 27, 2023.
