The applicant is providing on-site "behind the meter" stand-by power generation to a series of retail locations for a major food retailer in Ontario. Under its agreement with this customer, the Applicant will own and operate natural gas-powered generation assets which will be available to generate on site electricity in cases where the grid is down, to participate as Capacity under the IESO Capacity Auction (formerly Demand Response Auction), or to reduce store loads imported from the grid during IESO system peaks.

The applicant has an agreement to settle its power sales directly with the customer on a private basis, based on these factors. There is no plan to market or sell power to third parties or to export power onto the grid.

It is anticipated the power will be generated at site for a limited number of hours per year (less than 500). In all cases, the Applicant has executed Connection/Operating Agreements with the applicable LDC.
