KINGSTON COGEN LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

Application for an Electricity Retailer (Large Volume) Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

On June 12, 2023, Kingston CoGen Limited Partnership (Kingston CoGen) filed a complete application with the OEB under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence renewal to retail to large volume consumers only.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Kingston CoGen, is also a licensed electricity generator (EG-2003-0137) that owns and operates a 100MW natural gas fired cogeneration facility. Kingston Cogen indicated that while its electricity retailer licence had expired on March 7, 2023, it had not, in fact, conducted electricity retailing services at any time since being licensed in 2018.

After considering the evidence and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence to Kingston CoGen Limited Partnership.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application by Kingston CoGen Limited Partnership for an electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
