LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Hesselink:

Re: EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (EPCOR)
Application for Brockton Expansion Project
Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2022-0246

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for EPCOR's application for the **Brockton Expansion Project** (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 2 and 3 below **prior to August 4, 2023**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at registrar@oeb.ca.

You are directed:

- 1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on EPCOR's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of the enclosed Notice, in the exact form accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:

- a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
- b. the clerks of the Municipality of Kincardine, the Township of Arran-Elderslie, the Municipality of Brockton, the Municipality of West Grey, the Township of Chatsworth, Grey County, and Bruce County
- c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
- d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Suite 1100 66 Slater Street, Ottawa, ON K1P 5H1
- e. all affected utilities and railway companies
- f. the following government ministries and entities:
 - i. Environment and Climate Change Canada
 - ii. Fisheries and Oceans Canada
 - iii. the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority
- g. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- h. all parties in EB-2016-0137/0138/0139, EB-2018-0264, and EB-2022-0184

(Note: It is acceptable to serve the Notice, application and evidence by e-mail provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)

- 3. To make a copy of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at EPCOR's office and in a prominent place on EPCOR' website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the relevant Notices and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.
- 5. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
