DECISION AND ORDER

Northland Power Inc. filed an application on May 25, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Northland Power Inc. operates seventeen generation facilities (subject facilities) in Ontario, which are owned by its subsidiary companies (facility owners). The electricity generated from the subject facilities is sold into the Independent Electricity System Operator administered market, by the facility owners.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Northland Power Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
