Motion to Review and Vary the June 27, 2023 Decision and Order in EB-2023-0098

NOTICE OF HEARING AND PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 July 25, 2023

On June 27, 2023, after a written hearing, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) denied an application by Ontario Power Generation (OPG) for a variance account to record the nuclear revenue requirement impacts resulting from the November 29, 2022 decision by the Superior Court of Justice to strike down provincial legislation limiting wage increases for the broader public sector on constitutional grounds.¹

On July 17, 2023, OPG filed a notice of motion to review and vary the OEB's decision. OPG asks for approval to establish the variance account effective March 1, 2023 until the effective date of the OEB's next nuclear payment amounts order. OPG also asks that the interim variance account, which was approved on March 22, 2023 but rescinded by the June 27, 2023 decision, be reinstated.

OPG expressed a preference for the motion to be heard in writing.

Decision on Threshold Question

Under Rule 43 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, the OEB may determine, with or without a hearing, a threshold question of whether the matter should be reviewed before conducting any review on the merits.

The OEB has considered the threshold question in accordance with Rule 43 and has come to the view that the motion raises relevant issues material enough to warrant a review of the decision on the merits.

The OEB will hold a written hearing on the merits of OPG's motion.

Being eligible to apply for recovery of costs is not a guarantee of recovery of any costs claimed. OPG will be liable for any approved intervenor costs.

Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. To the extent that OPG wishes to make an argument-in-chief in addition to the arguments provided in its Notice of Motion, it shall file a written submission with the OEB and serve it on all other parties by **August 11, 2023**.
- 2. Any written submission by intervenors and OEB staff shall be filed with the OEB and served on OPG and all other parties by **August 28, 2023**.
- 3. Any reply submission by OPG shall be filed with the OEB and served on all other parties by **September 8, 2023.**

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*.
