DECISION AND ORDER

Energy Ottawa Inc. (Energy Ottawa) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 12, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant is currently licensed to own and operate three electricity generation facilities in Ontario, namely: Chaudière No. 2 Generating Station (Ottawa River), Chaudière No. 4 Generating Station (Ottawa River), and Chaudière Grinder Room Sluiceway Generating Station, all of which are located at Ottawa, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Energy Ottawa Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
