SCHEDULE 3 LIST OF CODE EXEMPTIONS

This Schedule specifies any specific Code requirements from which the Licensee has been exempted.

- A. The Licensee is exempt from the requirements of section 2.5.3 of the Standard Supply Service Code with respect to the price for small volume/residential consumers, subject to the Licensee offering an equal billing plan as described in its application for exemption from Fixed Reference Price, and meeting all other undertakings and material representations contained in the application and the materials filed in connection with it.
- B. The Licensee is also exempt until and including December 31, 2004 from the requirements of sections 2.7.2 and 2.7.3 of the Standard Supply Service Code.
 - Section 2.7.2 requires that bills to SSS customers shall only reference the distributor, even if a third party is providing the standard supply service. Section 2.7.3 requires that bills to SSS customers shall only include the distributor's marketing information or promotional materials, and materials or information that the distributor is obligated to send as part of its regulated distribution function.
 - 2. The exemptions from the requirements of sections 2.7.2 and 2.7.3 of the Standard Supply Service Code are conditional on the following:
 - a) There being no change in the licensing conditions or requirements for the operation of the Licensee's electricity assets or any change in the terms of sections 5(2) and 5(3) of Ontario Regulation 161/99 as amended by 144/02 or any change in the SSS Code materially impacting sections 2.7.2 or 2.7.3.
 - Implementation of the following billing presentation, effective 30 business days after May 12, 2003:
 - There is a clear statement at the top of the electricity portion of the
 proposed combined bill that the Licensee is the licensed distributor and
 provider of standard supply service to customers in the Licensee's
 service area and that Utilities Kingston is an affiliate which is providing
 billing and administrative services only.
 - The logo statement on the top of the Utilities Kingston bill and on any subsequent page (if applicable) is not to include the statement "water, sewer gas electricity networks, all your utility services under one roof" or any statement which may confuse customers that the affiliate, Utilities Kingston, is the licensed electricity operator or distributor.
 - c) There being no promotional materials included with the combined bill or as separate mailings which relate to any competitive activities in electricity, natural gas, water distribution and waste water collection and treatment.
- C. The Licensee is exempt from the requirement to implement time-of-use pricing as of the mandatory date for RPP customers with eligible time-of-use meters as required under the Standard Supply Service Code for Electricity Distributors. The mandatory time-of-use pricing date exemption expires on October, 31, 2011.
