As such, the IESO is an interested party and has an interest in all aspects of the proceeding.
3. The IESO intends to participate by, *inter alia*, submitting written evidence and answering interrogatories as necessary in respect of the Board's review and approval of the application. The IESO takes no position on whether the Board should deal with this matter by way of a written or oral proceeding
