**LATE NOTICE OF APPLICATION
FOR INTERVENOR STATUS**

1. The Township of South-West Oxford (the "Township") is a municipality in which Hydro One Networks Inc.'s ("Hydro One") proposed transmission line is to be constructed.
2. The transmission line described in the application is intended to serve the proposed Toyota facility in Woodstock. The Township is generally supportive of Hydro One's request for leave to construct the transmission line.
3. Although the Township is supportive of Hydro One's request for leave from the Ontario Energy Board, the Township wants to ensure that the transmission line does not unnecessarily interfere with any future reconstruction of Karn Road. The Township understands that the state of discussions between it and Hydro One is an issue for the Board.

4. While the Township reserves its full rights as an Intervenor to participate in this Proceeding, it anticipates making submissions in respect of the state of discussions with Hydro One and the location of the transmission line along Karn Road.
5. The Township accepts the record as it stands. The participation of the Township will not result in any delay to the Board's consideration of this matter nor will it result in any prejudice to any participant.
6. The Township will not be seeking a cost award.
