CAMPBELLFORD/SEYMOUR ELECTRIC GENERATION INC.

Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Campbellford/Seymour Electric Generation Inc. (CSEGI) filed an application on June 21, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

In its application, previous correspondence and documents issued by the Ontario Energy Board, including CSEGI's current licence, the applicant's legal name has been denoted as "Campbellford-Seymour Electric Generation Inc." or "Campbellford Seymour Electric Generation Incorporated" by error. However, pursuant to its incorporation documents, CSEGI confirmed its legal name as "Campbellford/Seymour Electric Generation Inc.".

CSEGI owns and operates two hydroelectric generation facilities, located in Trent Hills, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to CSEGI.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
