**DECISION AND ORDER**

TransAlta Cogeneration Limited Partnership (TransAlta) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 6, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence renewal.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant is currently licensed to own and operate two electricity generation facilities in Ontario, namely: Windsor-Essex Cogeneration Facility located at Windsor, Ontario and the Ottawa Cogeneration Facility located at Ottawa, Ontario.

The applicant has been previously licensed by the OEB and applied to renew its electricity generation licence EG-2003-0184, which will expire on October 20, 2023.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to TransAlta Cogeneration Limited Partnership

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
