I am writing on behalf of our client, Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters ("CME") to provide comments on Union Gas Limited's ("Union") QRAM Rate Application which seeks changes to Union's gas supply and transportation rates to reflect changes to the forecasted costs of purchasing and transporting natural gas.

We have reviewed Union's QRAM Application, and also sought clarification from Union on the 9.10 PJs of incremental gas purchased to meet demands above forecast for the period January 1, 2009 to February 28, 2009 [Tab 1, Page 6 of 8]. Based on the clarifications received by Union, CME is satisfied that the incremental gas purchased for sales service customers in the South and sales service and bundled direct purchaser customers in the North is consistent with the Board's Decisions on load balancing contained in RP-2003-0063 and EB-2005-0520. After receiving clarification from Union on the incremental gas purchased, CME is satisfied with Union's QRAM Application. As such, CME does not oppose the relief sought by Union.

We urge the Board to take comfort from the fact that Union's QRAM Application has been subject to ratepayer scrutiny. In our respectful submission, the review of QRAM Applications by CME contributes to the regulatory process.

CME requests an award of its reasonably incurred costs in connection with conducting its examination of Union's ORAM Application, including the clarification sought by CME. We will submit a claim for costs on behalf of CME if the Board responds favourably to this request.
