Re: Hydro Ontario Network Application of Electricity Rate Change

The report of January 23/08, Simcoe Reformer is very deceiving.

It states the possible decreases and increases percentages as:
Decrease 11 % ----- Increase - 9.8% for 1000 kw. Hr.
Decrease -21.5%----- Increase----8.9% for 2000 kw. Hr.
And an average of 1% increase-----

Questions
