
Once the Ontario Energy Board has approved the application for an increase in the Distribution Rate for Hydro One Networks Inc, Hydro One Networks Inc should be required to show each of its clients the composition of the rate and the change in each factor that composes the distribution rate.

The current distribution rate has both fixed and variable factors. The variable factors are based on actual and adjusted kilowatt-hours consumed.

As a user of electricity in Ontario it is very important to know how to reduce my electricity bill. For example if the fixed rate is increased by 15% then I know that I need not reduce any further my consumption of electricity because it will not significantly affect my over all monthly bill.

The fixed portion of the current distribution rate is most often greater than the electricity portion of my bill.
