DECISION AND ORDER

Cardinal Power of Canada, L.P. (Cardinal Power) filed an application on June 6, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Cardinal Power owns and operates an electricity generation facility located in Cardinal, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Cardinal Power.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
