On July 2, 2008, the Board announced that it was initiating a consultation process on the subject of low income energy consumers in relation to their use of natural gas and electricity.

By letter dated August 11, 2008 a list of issues and questions for discussion at the stakeholder conference was proposed. In that same letter the Board requested participants that wished to make a presentation during the stakeholder conference to file with the Board a letter to that effect by August 26, 2008 identifying the subject(s) to be addressed in their presentation. The list of interested participants who have requested to make a presentation has been posted on the Board's website. Also posted is an updated list of all participants who have expressed interest in this stakeholder consultation. Currently, 59 interested parties have registered to participate in this consultation.

Stakeholder Conference

The stakeholder conference will be held from September 22nd to 26th in the Board's North Hearing room 25th floor, 2300 Yonge Street, Toronto. An agenda for the conference is attached as Appendix A to this letter.

Presenters are asked to provide an overview of their presentations or the actual presentations to be made in advance of the conference. This will enable other

Due to the high interest in this conference and space limitations, the Board requests each organization to send only one or a maximum of two representatives to the conference. Consultant's Report

In the August 11, 2008 letter, the Board announced that Board staff had engaged Concentric Energy Advisors to produce a report summarizing the types of policies, programs or other measures that have been implemented in some other jurisdictions in addressing issues of concern to low income energy consumers. The report provides a starting point for stakeholder consultations. The report is posted on the Board's website.

Written Comments

The Board has decided to request written comments following the completion of the stakeholder conference. These comments will allow participants to summarize their views after having had the benefit of the views of other participants in the consultation. Written comments will be due October 7, 2008.

Cost Awards

In the July 2, 2008 letter, the Board announced that cost awards will be available to eligible parties for preparing for, attending at and reporting on the stakeholder conference, to a maximum of 40 hours.

On August 15, 2008 the Board issued its decision on cost eligibility in relation to this consultation. For those parties that are eligible for cost awards and wish to submit written comments after the completion of the stakeholder conference additional cost awards will be available to a maximum of 10 hours.
