Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Enerdu Power Systems Ltd. (Enerdu Power) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on July 17, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for renewal of its electricity distribution licence EG-2003-0188, which is set to expire on October 8, 2023.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant is currently licensed to own and operate a 1 MW generator located in Almonte, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Enerdu Power Systems Ltd.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
