**Applications for an Electricity Generation Licence and Electricity
Retailer Licence (Large Volume Consumers Only)**

DECISION AND ORDER

Enwave Windsor Holdings Limited Partnership (Enwave Windsor) filed applications on July 19, 2023, with the Ontario Energy Board under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence and an electricity retailer licence. The electricity retailer licence applied for would allow the applicant to retail electricity only to large volume consumers.

The OEB combined the applications into one proceeding, under section 21(5) of the OEB Act. This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the applications without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Enwave Windsor applied for an electricity generation licence to own and operate the Windsor Energy Centre, located at the Caesars Windsor Hotel & Casino, in Windsor, Ontario. Enwave Windsor has entered into an agreement to purchase the Windsor Energy Centre from the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation (OLG). Enwave Windsor states the transaction is expected to close on August 23, 2023.

Enwave Windsor has also applied for an electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence to allow it to sell the electricity generated to OLG, under an energy services agreement.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the applications and issue the electricity generation and electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence to Enwave Windsor Holdings Limited Partnership.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for an electricity generation licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.

2. The application for an electricity retailer (large volume consumers only) licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
