In regards to the Ontario Energy Board emails of May 1, 2007 we are pleased to provide the following responses:

TSSA

PIFFC intends to prepare a pipeline integrity management program for the proposed jet fuel pipeline.

A meeting was held with the TSSA on February 15, 2007. A copy of the meeting's minutes are attached. At the meeting it was confirmed that PIFFC will submit the requested Operation and Maintenance manuals to the TSSA.

We also wish to clarify that, as per point 1 of the meeting minutes, the TSSA later confirmed that the Tank Farm does not fall under the scope of Ontario Regulation 217/01. An email from the TSSA in regards to this is attached.

City of Mississauga Realty Services

The City's Realty Services has approved the installation of the proposed pipeline (see the attached email from Tom Penwarden dated Thursday April 19, 2007). The requested documentation is being prepared. It is anticipated that the agreement between the City and PIFFC will take a minimum of 6 months to finalize.

Region of Peel

Two submissions have been made to the Region of Peel for the proposed crossing of Derry Road East. As requested, copies of both submissions have been attached to this letter. Based on the March 12, 2007 submission the Region of Peel verbally requested that the separation between the proposed pipeline and the Derry Road sanitary sewer be increased to 1m. This revision was reflected on the April 4, 2007 submission. We have requested that the Region provide confirmation that they are satisfied with the proposed crossing. When this has been provided a copy will be forwarded to the Ontario Energy Board.
