We are pleased to provide the following information as requested by the Ontario Energy Board's letter of July 11, 2007.

(A) Corporate Information Regarding PIFFC

- (i) We confirm that Mr. James Fee is sole Director, President and Secretary of PIFFC.
- (ii) The completed affidavit was submitted to Mr. Peter O'Dell of the OEB on July 11, 2007.

(B) Status of Approvals

- (i) The TSSA's letter of January 30, 2007 confirmed that the proposed route is acceptable and that the design and pipe specification are adequate for the pipeline based on the proposed Maximum Operating Pressure (MOP). A copy of this correspondence is attached.

We note that the OEB was notified on April 26, 2007 that the proposed MOP was revised to 280psig. The system will still operate at a stress level below 30% of the pipe material's Specified Minimum Yield Strength (SMYS) based on the revised MOP. The detailed specifications and drawings for the proposed pipeline will also be submitted to the TSSA for their review.

- (ii) Please find attached a copy of the memo from the Region of Peel recommending that the Region commence with the preparation of the encroachment agreement across Derry Road.

Re: Jet Fuel Pipeline to Pearson International Airport

This is in response to your letter received on January 8, 2007, about the proposed construction of a 5.6 Km NPS 16 jet fuel pipeline from 7440 Torbram Road to its connection to the existing jet fuel storage and distribution system within the airport.


All alternatives for the proposed pipeline cross industrial areas and we agree with the selected route (Option 1). The design and pipe specification are adequate for this pipeline designed for a Maximum Operating Pressure (MOP) of 200 psig.

We understand that the Person International Fuel Facilities Corporation (PIFFC) will be the operator of this pipeline. As such, PIFFC will need to prepare the operation and maintenance documented procedures required in clause 10.2.1.1 of CSA Z662-03. In addition, the operating company shall consider the requirements of Section 2.(8) of the Director's Order FS-087-06 regarding pipeline integrity management program, although the system is going to be operated at a stress level lower than 30% SMYS.

Please notify us at least one week in advance of the date the welding of this pipeline will start.
