LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Vieira,

**Re: Pearson International Fuel Facilities Corporation
Application for Leave to Construct a Jet Fuel Pipeline
In the City of Mississauga
Board File Number: EB-2007-0009**

The Board has now issued its Notice of Application (the "Notice") with respect to the above noted application (the "Application").

You are directed:

1. to conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and facilities;
2. to immediately serve a copy of the Notice, the location map and a copy of the Application, either personally, by courier, or by registered mail on:
 - a. All directly affected landowners and on all encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the affidavit of search of title referred to in the first numbered paragraph above (duplicate copies need not be sent);

- b. All owners and operators of rail lines, telecommunications (e.g. telephone) or other utilities along or crossing the routes proposed for the project;
 - c. The Clerks of all townships and municipalities that would be affected by the project;
 - d. Greater Toronto Airports Authority;
 - e. All Native Bands and Reservations that would be affected by the project;
 - f. The following Federal Government departments and agencies:
 - Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency;
 - Natural Resources Canada;
 - Environment Canada; and
 - Transport Canada
 - g. The following Provincial Government ministries and agencies:
 - Ministry of Energy;
 - Ministry of the Environment;
 - Ministry of Natural Resources and the Ontario Secretariat for Aboriginal Affairs;
 - Ministry of Transportation;
 - Ministry of Government Services;
 - Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing;
 - Ministry of Culture;
 - Ontario Realty Corporation
 - Ministry of the Attorney General;
 - Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs; and
 - h. The following agencies and committees:
 - Toronto and Region Conservation Authority;
 - Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee.
3. To immediately have the English version of the Notice and location map, headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Ontario Energy Board", published in one issue of the local daily English language newspaper(s) having the highest paid circulation in the City of Mississauga according to the best information available.
4. To immediately arrange for the French version of the Notice, headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Commission de l'Énergie de l'Ontario", to be published in one issue of an appropriate French language weekly newspaper.

Note

Please make it clear to the newspaper(s) that the invoice regarding publication is to be sent to you, and not to the Board.

5. To file with the Board affidavit evidence proving the above service and publication immediately upon completion, with the relevant Notices, Application and location map, and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier delivery confirmation lists attached as appendices.

Notes

- (i) It is not necessary for the affidavits of publication to have newspaper tear sheets attached.
 - (ii) The affidavits of service referred to above must confirm that the Municipal Clerks served are the clerks of all affected municipalities, that the Native Bands and Native Reservations served are all of the Bands and Reservations affected, that the utilities and railway companies served are all utilities and railway companies whose lines would be crossed by the proposed pipeline, and that the property owners and encumbrancers so served are all owners and encumbrancers affected by the proposed construction.
6. To immediately make copies of the Application, the project information package and any additional materials, as developed, available for convenient public perusal at the offices of Pearson International Fuel Facilities Corporation at the address stated in the Notice.
 7. To immediately provide a copy of the Application to any person upon request.
 8. To immediately provide a copy of the project information package and any additional materials, as developed, to any person upon request.
