



**Alectra Utilities Corporation**

**Application for changes to electricity distribution rates  
in the PowerStream and Enersource Rate Zones  
effective January 1, 2024**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1  
August 30, 2023**

Alectra Utilities Corporation (Alectra Utilities) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on July 21, 2023, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, for approval of incremental capital mode (ICM) funding for ongoing investment in urgent underground cable renewal projects and a proposed alternative adjustment to the methodology to calculate the materiality threshold effective January 1, 2024.

A revised Notice of Hearing was issued on August 16, 2023. Each of the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario (AMPCO), Coalition of Concerned Manufacturers and Businesses of Canada (CCMBC), Consumers Council of Canada (CCC), Power Workers' Union (PWU), School Energy Coalition (SEC), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) applied for intervenor status. AMPCO, CCMBC, CCC, SEC and VECC also applied for cost eligibility.

No objection was received from Alectra Utilities.

AMPCO, CCMBC, CCC, PWU, SEC, and VECC are approved as intervenors. AMPCO, CCMBC, CCC, SEC, and VECC are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#). The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order.

Cost-eligible intervenors should be aware that the OEB will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. OEB staff and intervenors shall request any relevant information and documentation from Alectra Utilities that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on Alectra Utilities and all other parties by **September 13, 2023**.
2. Alectra Utilities shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on all intervenors by **September 28, 2023**.
3. Any written submissions by OEB staff and intervenors shall be filed with the OEB and served on all other parties by **October 18, 2023**.
4. Alectra Utilities may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on intervenors by **November 2, 2023**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories, and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*) unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's [Rules of Practice and Procedure](#).
