DECISION AND ORDER

Orillia Power Generation Corporation filed an application on August 23, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence EB-2003-0123, which is set to expire on October 16, 2023.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Orillia Power Generation Corporation owns and operates three hydroelectric generation facilities: Swift Rapids Generating Station located in Severn, Ontario, Minden Generating Station located in Minden Hills, Ontario, and Matthias Generating Station located in Bracebridge, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Orillia Power Generation Corporation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
