Re: Application for Electricity Retailer Licence Board File Number EB-2023-0191

This will acknowledge receipt of GC Project Inc., on behalf of GC Project LP's (GC Project) letter dated August 30, 2023, in response to the additional information requested in our letter dated August 3, 2023, pertaining to your application for an electricity retailer licence. A review of the submitted information indicates that your application remains incomplete and cannot be processed until the following have been filed:

- In our letter dated, August 3, 2023, we requested GC Project to confirm if you have continued to (since May 17, 2022) provide, to-date, any of the authorized activities under your expired electricity retailer licence, ER-2017-0098. You have provided information pertaining to your business activities, and not answered the specific question. We require a "Yes" or "No" answer to this question.
- 2. If the answer to the above question is "Yes," we requested GC Project to elaborate on the unlicensed activities being provided by the applicant, since the expiry of its electricity retailer licence. Instead, you have provided information pertaining to the electricity generation services provided by the applicant.

We did not receive an answer to the following question. If the answer to the above (2.) is "Yes", has the applicant taken steps to inform its customer(s) that it has been retailing electricity without a valid electricity retailer licence, since May 17, 2022.

The OEB will resume processing your application once the above information has been filed. If the above information is not filed within 30 days of the date of this letter, the OEB may close the file for this application.

Once your application is complete, the Delegated Authority expects to issue a final decision on your application within 60-90 days.

In the event the Delegated Authority decides to deny or otherwise modify the relief you requested in your application, you will be given an opportunity to provide comments. The Delegated Authority will consider your final comments, if any, prior to issuing a decision and order.
