DECISION AND ORDER

Kirkland Lake Power Corp. filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 14, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for a renewal of its electricity generation licence EG-2003-0101, which is set to expire on October 20, 2023.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Kirkland Lake Power Corp. owns one generation facility located in Kirkland Lake, Ontario.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Kirkland Lake Power Corp.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
