## **GREAT LAKES POWER LIMITED PARTNERSHIP**

## DECISION AND ORDER

Great Lakes Power Limited Partnership (Great Lakes Power) filed an application on August 15, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Great Lakes Power has listed twelve generation facilities (subject facilities), located in Ontario. The subject facilities are operated by Great Lakes Power, and owned by each of Great Lakes Power (50% ownership interest), Algoma Hydro Asset LP (25% ownership interest) under the authority of its electricity generation licence EG-2020-0208 and Canada Atlantis GL Power LP (25% ownership interest) under the authority of its electricity generation licence EG-2020-0209.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Great Lakes Power.

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
