Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. (NT Power) is scheduled to file its application for rates effective May 1, 2024, on or before on October 11, 2023, in accordance with the deadline for IRM filers assigned by the OEB to Tranche 2.<sup>1</sup> NT Power has experienced delays in preparing its application and regrettably will not be in a position to meet this deadline.<sup>2</sup> NT Power respectfully requests to be reassigned from Tranche 2 to Tranche 4, including an amended filing deadline of November 22, 2023. NT Power is committing substantive resources towards the preparation of this application and will endeavor to file earlier than that date, if possible.
