DECISION AND ORDER

Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) filed an application on July 31, 2023, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

OPG has listed sixty-eight generation facilities (subject facilities), located in Ontario. OPG is the owner and operator of majority of the subject facilities, and where the applicant has identified it as only the owner or operator of certain subject facilities, those subject facilities are operated or owned by licensees under the authority of their electricity generation licence, as required.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to OPG.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
