AMEREX BROKERS LLC

Applications for an Agent Only Electricity Retailer Licence and an Agent Only Gas Marketer Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Amerex Brokers LLC (Amerex) filed an application on September 12, 2023, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for a renewal of its electricity retailer licence (ER-2018-0307). Amerex also filed an application under section 50 of the OEB Act to renew its gas marketer licence (GM-2018-0308). Both licences are set to expire on January 9, 2024. The licence renewals would allow Amerex to continue acting as an agent or broker with respect to the sale or offering for sale of electricity or natural gas in Ontario.

The OEB combined the applications into one proceeding, pursuant to section 21(5) of the OEB Act. This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the applications and assessing the conduct, technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the applications and issue an agent only electricity retailer licence and an agent only gas marketer licence to Amerex Brokers LLC.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The application for an electricity retailer licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
- 2. The application for a gas marketer licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
