Membership of the Intervenor and Constituency Represented:

The PWU has approximately 15,000 members making up about 70% of the workforce in Ontario's electricity industry.

Programs or Activities Carried Out by the Intervenor:

The PWU carries out a wide variety of activities such as collective bargaining, advocacy regarding workplace safety matters, and participation in regulatory matters affecting its membership.

Governance Structure:

A President and three Vice Presidents, who are elected for four-year terms, lead the PWU. This leadership provides support and direction for an extensive network of Stewards across Ontario. The PWU also has a highly skilled staff of more than 50 people including a collective

bargaining research department, communications and government relations professionals, Health and Safety Staff Officers; a WSIB department to ensure fair compensation for workplace injuries or illnesses; experienced in-house legal counsel complete with a team of grievance specialists and more.

In OEB proceedings, authority to instruct the PWU's representatives is typically delegated to a small number of individuals within the PWU who are able to provide instructions on an asneeded and efficient basis.
