**Re: Request for Intervenor Status – Society of United Professionals
Hydro One Networks Inc. – Orillia and Peterborough Rate Zone
2024 Rebasing Application
OEB File Number: EB-2023-0059**

This letter is in response to your request for intervenor status on behalf of the Society of United Professionals (SUP) in the above referenced application.

In its letter requesting intervenor status, the SUP identifies that it “represents over 9600 professionals based primarily in the energy sector” and that it “represents over 2000 professional employees at Hydro One”. The SUP states that it wants to participate “as an intervenor in order to ensure that the interests of Hydro One employee stakeholders are fully represented in the review of the Application”.

The current proceeding will consider the reclassification of post-integration Low Voltage Variance Account transactions to sub-transmission revenue. The SUP did not raise any specific issues related to these accounting matters in its intervention request.

Rule 22.02 of the OEB’s Rules of Practice and Procedure provides that the party applying for status must satisfy the OEB that it has a “substantial interest” in the proceeding. Given the interests stated by the SUP and the scope of the current proceeding, the OEB finds that the SUP has not demonstrated that it has a substantial interest in this proceeding and therefore, its intervention request is denied.
