**Re: Correction to the Decision and Order of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener - Utilities Division - Application for Gas Marketer Licence  
OEB File Number EB-2023-0310**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued a Decision and Order in the above-noted proceeding on October 12, 2023. The Decision and Order granted the Corporation of the City of Kitchener – Utilities Division a gas marketer licence.

Upon receipt of the Decision and Order, the Corporation of the City of Kitchener – Utilities Division notified the OEB that the licence did not include the continuance of the current exemptions under the Code of Conduct for Gas Marketers (Code) and the Natural Gas Reporting and Record Keeping Requirements (RRR) as granted in previous OEB decisions for the renewal of Kitchener's gas marketer licence. The Corporation of the City of Kitchener – Utilities Division requested that the OEB grant the continuance of the current exemptions under the Code, specifically, Part B - Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 10, and the RRR, Sections 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3.

Today, the OEB is reissuing the Decision and Order in order to include the requested exemptions. Pursuant to Rule 41.02 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure, the OEB may at any time, without notice or a hearing of any kind, correct typographical errors, errors of calculation or similar errors made in its

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orders or decisions. The OEB considers this an administrative error pursuant to Rule 41.02. The Decision and Order is not otherwise changed in any way.
