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**I am respectfully submitting four issues, which I believe the Board should also address at these forthcoming hearings:**

- 1.** What cost-cutting measures did Hydro One take in the past three years that could have made this increase of its electricity transmission unnecessary?
- 2.** What were the results of these measures?
- 3.** Did Hydro-One consider the benefit-cost ratio of privatizing some of the maintenance of its power lines or rights-of-way for the purpose of cost reduction? If this was done, what was the ratio?
- 4.** In light of the current economic slowdown would it not be prudent to re-examine the forecast for the consumption of electrical energy and its effects on the transmission network?
