

NOTICE OF A RATE HEARING

Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation has applied to change its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2024

If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer of Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation will see no change, while a typical general service customer will see the following increase:

Residential (750 kWh)	\$0.00 per month
General Service less than 50kW (2,000 kWh)	\$4.34 per month

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected. It's important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation's 2022 earnings were in excess of the threshold set by the Ontario Energy Board. The Ontario Energy Board will review Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation's request for an increase in the context of its reported over earnings.

YOU SHOULD KNOW

There are three types of OEB hearings: oral, electronic and written. The applicant has applied for, and the OEB plans to proceed with, a written hearing. If you think a different hearing type is needed, you can write to us to explain why.

During this hearing, we will hear questions and arguments from participants about this case. We will also hear questions and arguments from participants that have registered as Intervenor. After the hearing, we will decide whether to approve the application.

If you do not, the hearing will move forward without you, and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. If you are a business or if you apply to become an intervenor, all the information you file will be on the OEB website.
