Re: Request Intervenor Status Board File No. EB-2007-0050

We hereby request Intervenor Status in order to participate in the proceedings of EB-2007-0050 Hydro One Networks Inc's Amended Application for Leave to Construct a new Transmission Line between the Bruce Power Facility and Milton Switching Station in Ontario. Our farm property falls into one of the three the local route alternatives in West Grey Township along this Hydro One transmission project – the yellow Potential Local Route Refinement Centreline Alt. 1.

The proposed transmission line and hydro towers will cut through our bush, cross the Habermehl Creek flowing through this bush, and straddle arable farm land. Hydro's bulldozing of a 250 ft open swath through the bush for the line and towers, will most probably affect the flow of the Habermehl Creek. A large portion in our bush had been replanted with coniferous and deciduous trees. This bush also contains some natural wetland due to some local natural springs. Alongside the usual wildlife of raccoons, rabbits, skunks, foxes, coyotes, and ground hogs our bush also houses a resident deer herd of approximately 6 – 10 animals. We watch the deer foraging in our bush or grazing in the backfield.

No one from Hydro One Networks Inc has personally contacted us to discuss this rerouting of the new transmission line. Since January 2008 we now receive some mail because we are located on the alternative route. Now there is a rush to read the materials and to apply for Intervenor Status with OEB.

With this letter we also request to obtain from Hydro One Networks Inc. legal costs and other costs, which will be incurred to be able to attend the OEB hearings in Toronto.


