Re: **EB-2022-0325**

The Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) seeks intervenor status in relation to Phase 2 of the OEB's generic hearing on uniform transmission rates.

The EDA is the voice of Ontario's local distribution companies (LDCs) and represents the interests of over 50 publicly and privately owned LDCs in Ontario. The distribution sector delivers approximately 120TWh of electricity to 5.4 million residential, commercial, industrial, and institutional customers throughout the province.

LDCs have a significant interest in the above-named proceeding and its outcome. LDCs would be interested in the number of decimal places for UTRs, the basis for billing gross load billing of renewable, non-renewable, an energy storage facility for transmission, and gross load billing thresholds for renewable and non-renewable generation.

The EDA reserves the right to participate in all aspects of this proceeding (e.g., testing the written pre-filed evidence, attending technical conferences, filing submissions). The EDA will not seek an award for costs and will not use the French language.
