Issues:

Upper Canada Transmission 2, Inc. seeks approval to change its electricity transmission rates effective, January 1, 2024. The application will consider the recovery and rate treatment of differences between actual versus budgeted construction costs, COVID-19 costs and debt financing costs related to the construction of the East-West-Tie line. AMPCO members are impacted by any change to the provincial transmission rate. There is no standard issues list. AMPCO intends to be engaged in all material issues in the proceeding.
