

DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS EB-2022-0156

ENBRIDGE GAS INC.

Application for leave to construct natural gas pipeline and associated facilities in the Township of Selwyn

OVERVIEW

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on January 18, 2023, under section 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, for an order granting leave to construct approximately 1.8 kilometres of 2-inch high-pressure pipeline and 6.6 kilometres of 4-inch high-pressure pipeline in the Township of Selwyn to supply natural gas to approximately 87 new customers.

The OEB granted Environmental Defence, Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario and Pollution Probe intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

On September 21, 2023, the OEB issued its Decision and Order which among other matters, set out the process for cost awards.

The OEB received cost claims from Environmental Defence, Federation of Rentalhousing Providers of Ontario and Pollution Probe.

On October 16, 2023, Enbridge Gas filed a letter with the OEB, stating they did not object to the cost claims from Environmental Defence, Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario and Pollution Probe.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that they are compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Enbridge Gas.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enbridge Gas shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:

•	Environmental Defence	\$5,680.51
•	Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario	\$3,915.45
•	Pollution Probe	\$6,991.89
