An Update

Natural gas prices have changed

The Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") has approved an increase to Enbridge Gas Distribution's Gas Supply, Customer and Delivery Charges effective July 1, 2008. For a typical residential customer, these changes will result in an increase of approximately \$298 annually, excluding the Gas Cost Adjustment and the Rate Adjustment. The increase is primarily due to an increase in transportation costs and North American natural gas prices. The effect on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

Gas Supply Charge

The Gas Supply Charge has increased from 30.3556 cents per cubic metre ("¢/m³") to 39.0121 ¢/m³. This price is based on a forecast of market prices for the next 12 months. The forecast price is reviewed every three months and, if necessary, adjusted accordingly to reflect market changes. If our forecasts are over or under our actual costs, we reimburse or collect the difference from customers through gas cost adjustments.

There is a new Gas Cost Adjustment refund of 0.8578 ¢/m³ for the period July 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008. This refund combined with the Gas Supply Charge results in a new total effective Gas Supply rate of 38.1543 cents per cubic metre.

Enbridge Gas Distribution does not make a profit on the cost of natural gas. The price we charge is the same as our cost to purchase natural gas.

Customer Charge and Delivery Charge

The cost of delivering natural gas to customers is included in the fixed monthly Customer Charge and the variable Delivery Charge.

The OEB has approved a change to the Customer Charge from \$11.95 to \$14 per month. The Customer Charge recovers fixed costs such as emergency response, meter reading and customer services, which are incurred regardless of the volume of gas used. To better reflect the fixed costs of providing gas distribution about \$25 per year in fixed charges were taken out of the Delivery Charge and added to the monthly Customer Charge.

As indicated above, \$25 was moved to the Customer Charge resulting in a corresponding decrease in the Delivery Charge. However, the cost of transporting natural gas to Ontario has increased by \$33 per year. Enbridge Gas Distribution does not make a profit on the cost of transporting natural gas. Combined, these changes result in a total annual increase in the Delivery Charge of about \$8. The Delivery Charge recovers variable costs such as transporting natural gas to Ontario as well as operating costs not recovered through the Customer Charge.

Rate Adjustment

The OEB has also approved a Rate Adjustment charge on the July and August bills for volumes consumed from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007. This reflects the difference between the actual costs incurred and the amount you paid over this period.

Natural gas prices have changed

The Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) has approved an increase to Enbridge Gas Distribution's Customer and Delivery Charges effective July 1, 2008. For a typical residential customer, these changes will result in an increase of approximately \$33 annually, excluding the Rate Adjustment. The increase is primarily due to an increase in transportation costs and North American natural gas prices. The effect on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

The price you pay for the natural gas you use, shown as the Gas Supply Charge on your bill, depends on the terms of your agreement with your gas marketer.

Customer Charge and Delivery Charge

The cost of delivering natural gas to customers is included in the fixed monthly Customer Charge and the variable Delivery Charge.

The OEB has approved a change to the Customer Charge from \$11.95 to \$14 per month. The Customer Charge recovers fixed costs such as emergency response, meter reading and customer services, which are incurred regardless of the volume of gas used. To better reflect the fixed costs of providing gas distribution about \$25 per year in fixed charges were taken out of the Delivery Charge and added to the monthly Customer Charge.

As indicated above, \$25 was moved to the Customer Charge resulting in a corresponding decrease in the Delivery Charge. However, the cost of transporting natural gas to Ontario has increased by \$33 per year. Enbridge Gas Distribution does not make a profit on the cost of transporting natural gas. Les prix du gaz naturel ont changé

La Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario (« CEO ») a approuvé une augmentation des prix du gaz, de distribution et de l'obligation au client facturés par Enbridge Gas Distribution, à compter du 1^{er} juillet 2008. Pour un abonné moyen de type résidentiel, ces changements équivaldront à une hausse d'environ 298 \$ par année, excluant le rajustement du coût du gaz et le rajustement de tarif. La hausse vient principalement de l'augmentation des coûts du transport et des prix du gaz naturel en Amérique du Nord. La répercussion de ce changement sur votre facture sera proportionnelle à votre consommation de gaz.

Prix du gaz

Le prix du gaz est passé de 30,3556 cents le mètre cube ($\text{\$/m}^3$) à 39,0121 $\text{\$/m}^3$. Ce prix repose sur une prévision des prix du marché au cours des douze prochains mois. Le prix est passé en revue tous les trois mois et, le cas échéant, est rajusté en conséquence pour refléter les fluctuations du marché. Si nos prévisions sont inexactes, nous remboursons nos clients ou percevons la différence en effectuant des rajustements du coût du gaz.

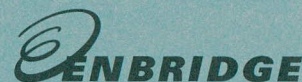

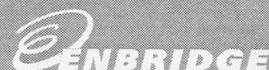
