



E.L.K. Energy Inc.

Application for electricity distribution rates and other charges beginning May 1, 2024

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 November 24, 2023

E.L.K. Energy Inc. (ELK Energy) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism (IRM) application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 11, 2023 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, seeking approval for changes to the rates that ELK Energy charges for electricity distribution, beginning May 1, 2024. ELK Energy has also applied for incremental capital funding for the purchase of two fleet vehicles and the purchase and installation of six recloser switches; as well as a Z-factor claim to recover the costs (and carrying charges) related to the damage caused to its distribution system by an ice storm and a thunderstorm.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on October 30, 2023. Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility.

No objection to VECC's intervention was received from ELK Energy.

VECC is approved as an intervenor and is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's <u>Practice Direction on Cost Awards</u>.

Cost eligible intervenors should be aware that the OEB will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed.

Being eligible to apply for recovery of costs is not a guarantee of recovery of any costs claimed. Cost awards are made by way of OEB order at the end of a hearing.

At this time the OEB is making provision for the filing of interrogatories, interrogatory responses, and submissions. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. VECC and OEB staff shall request any relevant information and documentation from ELK Energy that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written

interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on ELK Energy by **December 7**, **2023**.

- 2. ELK Energy shall file with the OEB and send to VECC complete written responses to the interrogatories by **January 11**, **2024**.
- 3. Any written submissions by VECC and OEB staff shall be filed with the OEB and served on ELK Energy by **January 25**, **2024**.
- Any reply submissions by ELK Energy shall be filed with the OEB by February 8,
 2024.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
