In its <u>September 28, 2023</u> letter the OEB initiated a consultation on Policy for Standby Rates. The OEB will host a stakeholder meeting to solicit input regarding current practices with respect to standby rates and to discuss options moving forward.

The OEB has a number of initiatives underway addressing distributed energy resources and related matters. The scope of this consultation will focus on distribution rates for standby service for customer-owned load displacement.

- Provide an overview of OEB staff's Capacity Reserve Charge proposal, detailed in the OEB staff paper on Commercial and Industrial Rate Design.

- Discuss options for default standby rate design.
- Discuss options for transition from interim to final rates.
