The Decision and Order issued on December 12, 2023 contained errors in the 'Total Claim' column for the Smart Metering Entity Charge Variance Account (Account 1551) and the RSVA - Wholesale Market Service Charge (Account 1580), both found in Table 7.1 on page 9 of the Decision and Order.

Pursuant to its powers under Rule 41.02 of the Ontario Energy Board (OEB)'s *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, the OEB may at any time, without notice or a hearing of any kind, correct a typographical error, error of calculation or similar error made in its orders or decisions.

The OEB has amended the Decision and Order to reflect the correct balances. The revised Decision and Order is attached. This revised Decision and Order supersedes and replaces the previously issued Decision and Order of December 12, 2023. The only changes contained in the Decision and Order are (i) the amounts found in the 'Total Claim' column for the Smart Metering Entity Charge Variance Account (Account 1551) and the RSVA - Wholesale Market Service Charge (Account 1580) in Table 7.1; and (ii) the preceding sentence which incorrectly identifies the Table as "Table 6.1" not "Table 7.1".
