Frequent Intervenor Form:

OEB Proceedings:

CCMBC has been granted intervenor status in the following OEB proceedings in the last 24 months: EB-2022-0002, EB-2022-0079, EB-2022-0013, EB-2022-0016 and EB-2023-0004. It has not been denied intervenor status in any proceeding.

Issues:

Members of CCMBC are manufacturers and businesses many of whom are customers of Toronto Hydro and will be affected by the proposed rates increases. CCMBC is concerned that load forecasts and the amounts, need and timing of capital and OM&A expenditures that are causing the proposed rate increases may not be appropriate.

Policy Interests:

CCMBC has no policy interests in this proceeding.

Hearings:

CCMBC has no preference for a specific type of hearing.

Evidence:

CCMBC does not intend to file evidence.

Coordination with Other Intervenors:

CCMBC intends to co-ordinate its efforts with other intervenors by sharing drafts of interrogatories and submissions.

Cost Awards:

The CCMBC is a non-profit organization which relies on membership fees and individual donations to help protect the interests of its 418 member manufacturers and other businesses who are all electricity consumers. CCMBC will be requesting an award of costs for its participation in this proceeding and believes that, as a coalition representing the direct interests of electricity consumers, it meets the eligibility criteria set out in the Ontario Energy Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure and its' Practice Direction on Cost Awards.
