BOMA represents the industrial and commercial building owners' interests. Provincial and municipal governments are putting policies in place that require industrial and commercial

building owners, along with other building owners, to invest in electrification, DERs, energy efficiency and other energy transition strategies. Toronto Hydro's Incentive Application and investment plan will need to support and incent building owners through this transition while maintaining affordability.
