Peterborough Distribution Inc. has filed an application with the Chlaric Energy Board, (the "Board") received on October 10, 2008 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, 8.O. 1998, a. 15 (Schedule B), secting approval for changes to the rates that Peterborough Distribution Inc. charges for electricity distribution, to be affective May 1, 2009. The Board has assigned the application File No. E8-2008-0241. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of Peterborough Distribution inc.'s customers.

Any change to Peterborough Distribution inc.'s distribution rates will cause Peterborough Distribution Inc.'s delivery charges to change. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service outstomers' electife bits and very depending on the amount of electificity consumed.

In its application, Peterborough Distribution inc. is seeking approved of \$15,763,249 as the 2009 revenue requirement it requires to provide electricity distribution services. On an equivalent basis, this compares with a Board-approved level of \$14,851,426 for 2006, the last year the rates were reviewed on a cost of service basis. During the Interim period, the Board has approved adjustments to distribution rates.

In addition, Peterborough Distribution linc, is seeking approved to harmonize the rates it changes within its three service areas of Asphodel-Norwood, Lakefield and Peterborough. Peter-borough Distribution linc, indicates that if the application is approved as filled, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience varying increases in the current delivery charges component of their bill, depending on where they reside as follows:

- In the Aspholet-Norwood service area, an increase of approximately 9.6% in the current delivery charges. This is an increase of approximately \$3.05 per month on the bill. In the Lakefield service area, an increase of approximately \$1.3% in the current delivery charges. This is an increase of approximately \$3.50 per month on the bill. In the Peterborough service area, an increase of approximately 4.7% in the current delivery charges. This is an increase of approximately \$1.57 per month on the bill.

Similarly, a general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of less than 50 kW would experience varying increases in the current delivery charges component of their bill, depending on where they are located as follows:

- In the Asphodel-Norwood service area, an increase of approximately 13.6% in the current delivery charges. This is an increase of approximately \$7.83 per month on the bill. In the Lakefield service area, an increase of approximately 8.0% in the current delivery charges. This is an increase of approximately \$4.55 per month on the bill. In the Peterborough service area, an increase of approximately 11.2% in the current delivery charges. This is an increase of approximately \$3.54 per month on the bill.




