
All of my previous cost award filings have been for intervenors that have been Unregistered for GST purposes.

1. The intervenor will be identified as a Full Registrant. Should the intervenor provide their GST registration number here as well, as seems to be implied in Section 9.03 (b) of the Practice Directions?
2. For a Full Registrant, should the Total GST Claimed portion of the Total Cost Claim section be set by default to \$0.00?
3. Is any other information required that is not required for an Unregistered intervenor?
