On September 23, 2008, the Board received a letter from Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) requesting intervenor status and cost award eligibility for the Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited (Innisfil) application for approval of 2009 electricity distribution rates.

The Board has considered VECC's request and confirms VECC as an intervenor in this proceeding.
