**I, Matthew Kirk, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, Director, Ontario Regulatory Affairs, Ontario Power Generation Inc.,**

**MAKE OATH AND SAY:**

1. In my capacity as Director, Ontario Regulatory Affairs with Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG"), I was charged with the responsibility of arranging for publication of the Notice of Hearing for OPG's Application for an order or orders relating to impacts from the Market Renewal Program on prescribed generating facilities, and the disposition of balances in its deferral and variance accounts as of December 31, 2022 (the "Notice"), pursuant to the Ontario Energy Board's Letter of Direction dated January 29, 2024 (the "Letter of Direction").



# NOTICE OF A HEARING

## Ontario Power Generation Inc. has applied to dispose of the balances of certain deferral and variance accounts and for changes relating to impacts from the Independent Electricity System Operator's Market Renewal Program on prescribed generating facilities

Ontario Power Generation Inc. has applied for changes to the calculation of amounts for the Hydroelectric Surplus Baseload Generation Variance Account and the Hydroelectric Incentive Mechanism, and for the treatment of real-time make whole payments. These proposed changes are based on expected changes to Ontario's electricity market that will be made under the Independent Electricity System Operator's Market Renewal Program. OPG is also asking for approval to dispose of certain deferral and variance accounts.

If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer consuming 700 kWh per month would see the following monthly increase:

	July to December 2024	2025	2026
<b>Residential (700 kWh)</b>	\$1.06	\$0.05	\$0.15

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected. It's important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

### YOU SHOULD KNOW

There are three types of OEB hearings: oral, electronic and written. The applicant has applied for, and the OEB plans to proceed with, a written hearing. If you think a different hearing type is needed, you can write to us to explain why.

During this hearing, we will hear questions and arguments from participants about this case. We will also hear questions and arguments from participants that have registered as Intervenors. After the hearing, we will decide whether to approve the application.

**Ontario Power Generation Inc. a déposé une demande pour disposer des soldes de certains comptes de report et d'écart, et pour des changements relatifs aux impacts du Programme de renouvellement du marché de la Société indépendante d'exploitation du réseau d'électricité sur les installations de production prescrites.**


